2024-2027 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (MTIP)

Date: June 13, 2026

The Bend Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) maintains each active MTIP. The funding and projects or project phases programmed often change over the MTIP period. For transparency, a current amendment log is regularly published on the [BMPO MTIP webpage](#).

There are two types of amendments – administrative and full. Administrative amendments are processed internally by BMPO staff while full amendments involve a public process and BMPO Policy Board review and approval prior to processing.¹

Summary of Amendments

BMPO staff have processed 131 amendments (83 administrative and 48 full) for projects in the 2024-2027 MTIP since the program was adopted in May 2023. Table 1 shows how many amendments have been processed for projects under each applicant.² Tables 2-7 provide project information and amendment detail.³
