

RESOLUTION NO. 2843

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF DESIGNATED RECIPIENT STATUS TO CENTRAL OREGON INTERGOVERNMENTAL COUNCIL

Findings

- A. The City of Bend previous operated an intra-city bus service, including both fixed-route and dial-a-ride services, known as Bend Area Transit (BAT).
- B. By intergovernmental agreement, the City transferred responsibility for BAT to the Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council (COIC). The agreement provided for a one year trial period, followed by a more permanent transfer after one year.
- C. The one year trial period is nearing completion and the parties are committed to continuing to have COIC operate BAT for the remainder of the agreement period. The agreement calls for transfer of grants the City had received for BAT to COIC if the agreement is to proceed past the one year trial period.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City transfers all rights and responsibilities for all grants received by BAT to COIC. This transfer is effective retroactively to July 1, 2011.
- Section 2. COIC shall be the designated recipient for all grants for BAT service and equipment. COIC is authorized to provide annual certifications, assurances and other documents that are or may be required in connection with any state or federal assistance grant or cooperative agreement for BAT service or equipment.
- Section 3. This resolution takes effect immediately on passage.

Adopted by the City Council the 6th day of July 2011.




