ORDINANCE NO. NS-2193

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE RIGHT OF WAY OF NE VAIL AVENUE BETWEEN NE 3RD AND 4TH STREETS. (See attached Exhibits A and B)

Findings:

- A. On July 10, 2012, C. E. Francis, of Francis Hansen & Martin LLP filed a petition on behalf of Koppel LLC and Robberson Ford (collectively "Applicants") to vacate the right of way of NE Vail Avenue between NE 3rd and 4th Streets (the "Petition"), and on August 1, 2012, the City Council directed staff to proceed to process the Petition.
- B. On September 2 & 9, 2012, the City published notice of a public hearing on the vacation of NE Vail Avenue between NE 3rd and 4th streets in The Bulletin, a newspaper of general circulation in the City once each week for two consecutive weeks, consistent with ORS 271.110.
- C. Within five days after the first day of publication of the notice, the City posted notice of the proposed street vacation at or near each end of the proposed vacation and in at least two conspicuous places in the proposed vacation area. The first publication and posting of the notice occurred not less than 14 days prior to the hearing on the proposed vacation. The City Council opened a public hearing on September 26, 2012 and continued the hearing to November 7, 2012.
- D. The City Council reopened the public hearing on the proposed vacation on November 7, 2012.
- E. The Petitioner complies with applicable standards and the Applicants have submitted the required number of signatures for the Petition to be approved.
- F. The City Council has determined that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the proposed vacation and that the property should be vacated.

Based on these findings, THE CITY OF BEND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. NE Vail Avenue, between NE 3rd and 4th Streets, in the City of Bend, Deschutes County, Oregon, is vacated on the following conditions:
 - 1. That Applicants pay \$283,300.00 to be used for right-of-way acquisition, improvements and maintenance. In addition they will pay recording and noticing costs prior to recording this vacation ordinance.
 - 2. That Applicants provide a public utility easement for the gas and power utilities remaining within the area to be vacated.
 - 3. That Applicants provide a public easement for the existing public hydrant and water utilities as shown on the site exhibit.

- Section 2. When the City Manager has certified in writing that the conditions have been fulfilled, the City Recorder shall file and record this Ordinance in the Deschutes County Clerk's Office.
- Section 3. If the conditions are not fulfilled within one year from this Ordinance's effective date, this Ordinance shall be null and void.




LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF AREA TO BE VACATED
