## **RESOLUTION NO. 2917**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND, OREGON DECLARING OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES INCURRED FROM THE PURCHASE OF FIRE/EMS EQUIPMENT AND DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF WATER AND WATER RECLAMATION INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE BRIDGE CREEK PIPELINE MAINTENANCE (INCLUDING LINE REPLACEMENT/RELOCATION) AND THE SOUTHEAST INTERCEPTOR PROJECTS, WITH THE PROCEEDS OF SUBSEQUENTLY ISSUED DEBT.

## <u>Findings</u>

- A. The City intends to purchase fire/EMS equipment and design and construct water and water reclamation infrastructure improvements, including but not limited to the Bridge Creek Pipeline Maintenance (including line replacement/relocation) and the Southeast Interceptor projects, (collectively, the "Projects").
- B. The City anticipates incurring expenditures (the "Reimbursement Expenditures") in connection with the Projects prior to the issuance of indebtedness for the purpose of financing costs associated with the Projects on a long-term basis.
- C. The City reasonably expects to issue one or more series of debt obligations in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$49,000,000 and wishes to declare its official intent to reimburse itself for the Reimbursement Expenditures from the proceeds of debt to be issued for the Projects.
- D. Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations (the "Treasury Regulations") requires the City to declare its reasonable official intent to reimburse prior expenditures for the Projects with proceeds of a subsequent borrowing.

BASED ON THESE FINDINGS, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Declaration of Intent. The City declares its official intent to use proceeds of one or more series of debt obligations to reimburse itself for Reimbursement Expenditures.
- Purpose of Resolution. This Resolution is adopted solely for purposes of establishing compliance with the requirements of Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations. This Resolution does not bind the City to make any expenditure, incur any indebtedness, or proceed with the Projects.
- 3. Effectiveness. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.
