

# LANDSCAPE WATER REQUIREMENTS

The City of Bend is proud to partner with:

Water requirements vary throughout the landscape depending on the time of season, region of the yard and plant type. Unfortunately, many landscape irrigation controllers are set to water at levels required in mid-summer or "peak season". Instead, irrigation schedules should be continually adjusted throughout the growing season. Never "Set it and forget it".

# SPRINKLER INSPECTION PROGRAM



### UTILITY DEPARTMENT

The Water Wise Sprinkler Inspection Program is a free sprinkler program available to City of Bend customers.

## Why should I participate?

- It's a professional service provided at no charge to you, with substantial benefits to your landscape.
- Receive a customized watering schedule, based on your systems performance, for a healthy landscape.
- Learn about your irrigation system, how to maximize its performance and simple tips for using water wisely.
- Learn about when and how much to water as well as identifying ways to save.

# When can I get an inspection?

The Sprinkler Inspection Program runs during the growing season starting in May.

# How much does the sprinkler inspection cost?

This valuable information is being provided as a public service by the City of Bend at no charge.

# How long will it take?

Appointments are scheduled for one hour, having specific questions prepared can help make best use of the visit.



# What happens at the inspection?

Sprinkler inspections are conducted by City of Bend Water Wise program staff and include the following:

- A visual inspection of the system running to identify any issues affecting performance.
- Tests to measure system precipitation rate, pressure and efficiency.
- Soil samples taken to determine plant root depth and landscape soil type.

# What will I get after the inspection?

A customized report emailed to you containing issues found during the inspection, an optimized watering schedule, and tips to improve efficiency.
