

To control sewer odors in the Valhalla neighborhood, the City of Bend is about to build a new sewer line in the Valhalla neighborhood area. Crews will install new sewer piping down Mount Washington and along Shevlin Park Road, and will build an odor control facility near the roundabout. Upon successful completion of the project, the City will be able to stop using expensive chemicals to control odors.

Work will begin at the roundabout of Mount Washington Drive and Shevlin Park Road in early July.

The first phase of the project will require closing each leg of the roundabout, one leg at a time, and this work will be done between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. Detours will be marked. Following the roundabout area, the sewer line construction will progress along Mount Washington toward Regency Street. This work will occur during day hours. One of the two main access points into the Valhalla neighborhood from Mount Washington Drive (Polarstar and Nordic) will always be open to local traffic.

Detours will be marked, and will change depending on where the work is happening at any given time.

Timelines will fluctuate depending on how quickly crews are able to progress, but construction is currently planned for July through November.
