# DSAC Brainstorm - Strategy Framework



- **Summer** is definitely the **peak season**.
- **Parking Behavior:** Little variation in user behavior between seasons (visitors/employees).
- **High Use Areas (On-Street):** There is a defined area of high parking activity (very constrained and sustained at 85%+) in the downtown core or center, which operates much differently than the east side of downtown.
- **Off-Street Parking Availability:** The off-street system has a meaningful amount of unused parking, particularly in the parking garage.

# DSAC Brainstorm - Strategy Framework



- **Shared Use:** There are opportunities to find and identify shared use facilities for off-street parking (public and private lots).
- **Mirror Pond lots** are consistently constrained.
- **Parking Plan:** There is a finite supply of parking in downtown Bend. New systems need to be implemented to direct intended users into available supplies.
