## DSAC Brainstorm - Strategy Framework

- Summer is definitely the peak season.
- Parking Behavior: Little variation in user behavior between seasons (visitors/employees).
- **High Use Areas (On-Street)**: There is a defined area of high parking activity (very constrained and sustained at 85%+) in the downtown core or center, which operates much differently than the east side of downtown.
- Off-Street Parking Availability: The off-street system has a meaningful amount of unused parking, particularly in the parking garage.

## DSAC Brainstorm - Strategy Framework

- Shared Use: There are opportunities to find and identify shared use facilities for off-street parking (public and private lots).
- Mirror Pond lots are consistently constrained.
- **Parking Plan**: There is a finite supply of parking in downtown Bend. New systems need to be implemented to direct intended users into available supplies.
