RESOLUTION NO. 3088

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING SUPPORT OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S APPLICATION FOR THE FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE FOR REBUILDING AMERICA GRANT

Findings

- A. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) plans to apply for the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant from the federal Department of Transportation.
- B. The INFRA grant requires state and local matching funds.
- C. ODOT will use the funds to construct, reconstruct, and/or repair transportation infrastructure in the North End of the City of Bend, including US-97, US-20, and Cooley Road.
- D. The transportation infrastructure improvements to US-97, US-20, and Cooley Road are vital to the continued growth of the City of Bend and development of the north end of the City, including the implementation of the expanded Urban Growth Boundary.
- E. The City desires to support ODOT's application for the INFRA grant.
- F. The grant application project is consistent with the approved Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) US 97 Bend North Corridor Project
- G. The City Transportation System Plan (TSP) was amended to include the alignments and projects approved in the EIS.

Based on these findings, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City of Bend supports the Oregon Department of Transportation application for the federal Department of Transportation Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant for improvements to US-97, US-20, and Cooley Road in the north end of the City.
- Section 2. Staff proposes using \$2.5 million of Transportation Construction Fund reserves for the INFRA grant application match. Funding for the \$3 million contribution for improvements in the Juniper Ridge Urban Renewal Area is anticipated to be available by 2021 in the Juniper Ridge Urban Renewal Funds and would be restricted for transportation projects in the Urban Renewal Plan.
- Section 3. This resolution takes effect immediately on passage.
