

How to turn on Hydrant Layer in Dial

1.) Enter the property address

Search by one or more different property-related fields: Owner Name, Account #, Map/Taxlot, Situs Address, Subdivision, or Mobile Home Park.

Ex: "Deschutes Library Wall St" or "Library Wall"

Less is more - Simple, two or three word search terms will usually give you the broadest results. Start with fewer or partial search terms, then use the fast filters on the results page to refine your results.


2.) From the Summary of Account Page Click on the Interactive Map




3.) Click Add Layers (Left side just under the brown banner)



4.) Click on Fire Hydrants



- 5.) Close the pop up window
- 6.) To measure distant click on the measure tool (right side of tool bar with the add layers option).



- 7.) Click the rule (middle icon of the pop up box)

8.) The measurement will display in the bottom left corner of the pop-up box.

9.) Default measurement is in feet, click the drop down arrow to change if necessary. Hydrants only display on the first three ticks of the zoom bar, if it's too far out you will not see hydrants.
