RESOLUTION OF ASSESSMENT

Findings

- A. The Downtown Economic Improvement District was created for the purposes of funding economic improvement projects within the district. Improvement projects include but are not limited to flower baskets, beautified planters, assistance with sidewalk snow removal, sidewalk sweeping and debris removal, graffiti removal, winter tree lights, holiday wreaths, banners, benches, trash receptacles, marketing downtown to promote business, event coordination, advertising and events.
- B. The City Council established the District by Ordinance No. 2305, adopted March 7, 2018. Notice of the proposed assessment was mailed to the owner and/or contract purchaser of each property to be assessed. The City Council considered the proposed assessment and objections on April 18, 2018, and determined that the cost of the improvement has been apportioned in accordance with law.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
