

RESOLUTION 3175

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF PHASE TWO OF THE NORTH INTERCEPTOR SEWER PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PROCEDURES TO CARRY OUT THE PROJECT

Findings

- A. The City of Bend ("City") entered into the North Interceptor Sewer Project Design-Build Contract with M.A. Mortenson Company, dated June 14, 2018. The North Interceptor Sewer Project includes three phases. Phase 1 is currently under construction. The Bend City Council approved a contract amendment for preconstruction and design services for Phase 2 of the North Interceptor Sewer Project ("the Project") on October 2, 2019. The Project will connect the west end of Phase 1 of the North Interceptor Sewer Project to US-97, as generally shown on the attached Exhibit A.
- B. Pursuant to ORS chapter 35, ORS chapter 223, and ORS 224.020, the City has the authority to engage in activities that promote the health, safety, benefit and general welfare of the public and is authorized to acquire, own and operate utilities and sewer systems within and without city limits.
- C. The City and its authorized assigns may be required to enter onto property for the purposes of examining, surveying, sampling and testing for purposes of determining the route, alignment, and location of the Project so that it is planned or located in a manner which will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

Based on these findings, the City Council of the City of Bend resolves as follows:


Section 1. The Council declares that this Project is for a public purpose and is necessary in order for the City to provide sewer service within the City's adopted urban growth boundary.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, and the City Attorney are authorized to carry out the activities necessary for the examining, surveying, sampling and testing for purposes of the Project and to negotiate and acquire property for the Project.

Section 3. This resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.



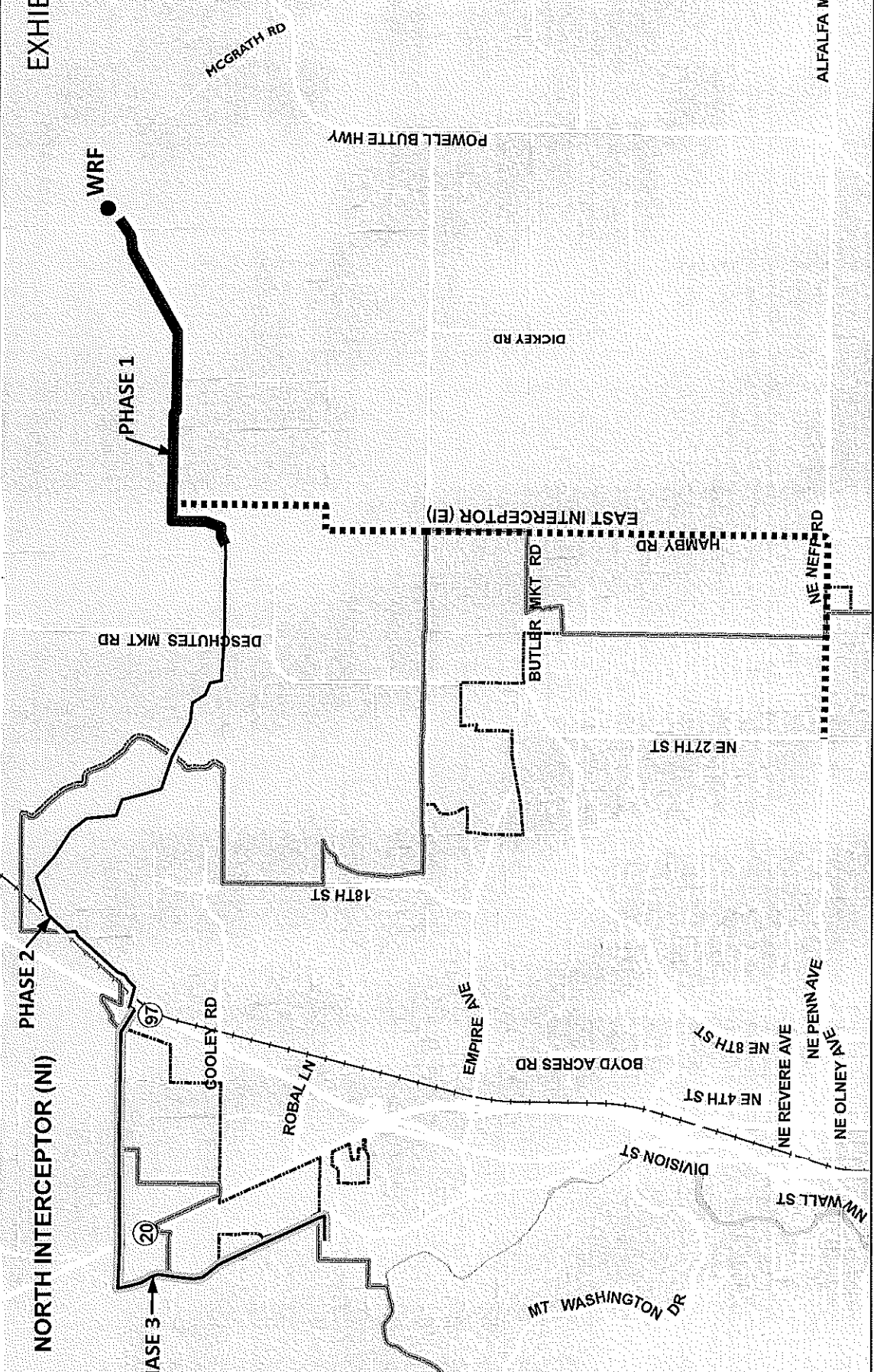
