This Exception Form is required when a street cut in a public street is included as part of a Public Right-of-Way Permit Application and Class "C" or "D" Asphalt Concrete as shown on the City of Bend Standard Drawing R-10 is not available.

Permittee agrees to the following additional permit requirements:

- 1. A street cut trench shall be constructed in accordance with the City of Bend Pavement Restoration Requirements Section 3.8 per City of Bend Construction Specifications (latest edition).
- 2. If Asphalt Concrete material is not available, a trench shall be constructed per the City of Bend Standard Drawing R-10 and cold mix asphalt used in place of Asphalt Concrete.
- 3. The Permittee is responsible to maintain the temporary street patch to the satisfaction of the City until a permanent repair can be constructed per the City of Bend Standard Drawing R-10. Failure to repair a temporary street patch within 48 hours' request by the City shall constitute a violation of the Right-of-Way Permit.
- 4. The permittee is responsible for completion of final restoration within 45 days' reopening of asphalt plants.
- 5. The City has the ability to enforce violations for failure to maintain or restore the site. Failure to

- restore the site within the 45 day window will result in withholding issuance of new permits and/or a Class D Civil Infraction with a fine of \$750 per day.
- 6. If Permittee fails to make restoration as required or restoration fails within the one year warranty period, City may, after notice to Permittee, cause the repairs to be made at the expense of Permittee. If Permittee fails to reimburse the City for any costs incurred within 45 days' demand for reimbursement, City may refuse to issue additional permits.
