Bend Metropolitan Planning Organization FY2019-20 MPO Supplemental Budget August 20, 2019 Policy Board Action



Issue Summary

An amendment to the Bend Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020 Budget is required. The 2019-2020 budget was adopted in April 2019. In June 2019, the Policy Board approved additional funds from the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) in the amount of \$59,119 for personnel services to increase the senior planner position from 0.6 to 0.8 full time equivalent and extend the position through FY2019-20. This proposed amendment to the FY2019-20 budget reflects the additional personnel funds approved in June.

The work tasks in the Budget and Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) do not change. The level of effort to complete the programmed tasks require additional staff time.

Description

Resolution Budget 2019-06 adds personnel service funds. No change in tasks or work programs are considered. This change is based on work load and level of effort requirements to complete the projects and programs currently in the 2019-20 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and Budget documents adopted on April 16, 2019.
