





### STEERING COMMITTEE GOAL DECISION HISTORY



#### March 2018:

- Introduced the transportation planning process
- Discussed vision and values guidance to CTAC

## May 2018:

Discussed Transportation Goals

# September 2018:

Approved Transportation Goals

#### **STEERING COMMITTEE PROTOCOLS**



- "Prior decisions made by the SC by consensus or vote may be reconsidered when there is a consensus or a majority vote approving a reconsideration. The Project Director will inform the SC of potential impacts to the budget and schedule when substantive issues are proposed for reconsideration."
- Because the Goals were approved by the Steering Committee on September 11, 2018; a majority of Steering Committee must support reopening of the goals, prior to any discussion of changing language.

#### STEERING COMMITTEE CHOICES FOR GOALS



- 1. Leave the goals as they were adopted on September 11, 2018 (*Project Team recommendation*)
  - No motion required.

#### OR

- 2. Vote to reopen the discussion:
  - Reopen the goals to adopt minor edits only (red font)
  - Reopen discussion on goals (blue font)
    - Potential motion: I move to reopen and reconsider the Goals previously approved by the Steering Committee.

# REMINDER: ORIGIN OF THE POLICIES & ACTIONS



- Transportation Goals
- Existing TSP policies
- Input from Open House & Neighborhood Workshops
- Staff review, particularly Legal
- Examples from similar cities
- Actions grew out of policies (non-regulatory)

# POLICY DEVELOPMENT HISTORY



- February March 2019: CTAC sub-committees met 3-5 times to draft policies and actions;
- April, May & June 2019: Full CTAC meetings to review and refine policies and develop actions
- June 2019: Draft policies (work-in-progress) brought to Steering Committee as informational item
- July and November 2019: CTAC workshops to further refine policies and actions
- December 2019: CTAC recommendation to forward policies and actions to Steering Committee
- January 2019: Steering Committee review of policies and actions

# POSSIBLE STEERING COMMITTEE ACTIONS ON POLICIES



- 1. Approve minor edits to clarify and/or add completeness or consistency (red).
- 2. For substantial policy edits (blue), generally retain the CTAC recommendations, except for edits needed for legal reasons or to support existing City practices.
  - In a few circumstances, the Project Team is neutral (<u>black underline</u>) or has suggested alternative language (**bold italics**).
  - *NOTE*: Please see Legal memo relating to requiring a vote prior to any imposition of additional revenue streams (Policy 49).
- 3. For edits to actions (purple) generally retain the CTAC recommendations.
  - Except for the action related to Policy 17, added to reflect coordination with ODOT.

# SUGGESTED GROUPINGS & SAMPLE MOTIONS



- 1. Consider the minor edits (red font)
  - I move that the minor edits in Table 2 be approved (if needed, add as amended).
- 2. For each of the seven groupings (Safety, Mobility, etc.), potential motions:
  - I move approval of the policies and action items as recommended by the project team

OR

• I move approval of the policies and action items per the proposed changes [specify the changes].
