Affected properties along these publicly funded sewer extension projects will receive a Notice of Operational Completion (NOC) when the sewer is operational and available for connection.

This form must accompany the submittal for plumbing permit submittal with the Building Safety Division. A copy of the Tank Abandonment (TA) permit shall be provided to the City at the time of obtaining signature to this form and obtaining a plumbing permit. Deschutes County permits septic system repairs and abandonments.

Sewer Utility billing will begin within 60 days of plumbing permit unless extension is approved.
