ODOT is planning a study that will determine the location of an interchange, that will connect to an extension of 18th St. through Juniper Ridge, and other important transportation improvements in the U.S. Hwy. 97 corridor. U.S. Hwy. 97 is an important lifeline for Central Oregon, and continued population growth in the Bend-Redmond area will continue to increase demands on U.S. Hwy. 97 in the future. These changes will likely have major impacts on businesses and residents along the corridor beyond for many years to come, and that's why ODOT wants to hear from everyone with a stake or interest in the future look and function of a transportation in the North 97 corridor.
