- Adopted by Council in 2006
- Collected on <u>all Building Permits</u>
- Assessed at 0.33%
- 2019-2021 Budget Annual Projections:
  - \$391,000,000 Total Building Valuation
  - \$1,290,300 Affordable Housing Fee funding annually

## **2016 STATE RULES FOR CONSTRUCTION EXCISE TAXES**



- City of Bend Affordable Housing Fee exempted from 2016 rules
- Any new <u>residential</u> Construction Excise Tax (CET) must:
  - Assessment rate may NOT exceed 1 percent
  - May NOT be charged on affordable housing buildings
  - 50% allocated for Developer Incentives
  - 15% returned to the State for down payment assistance
  - 35% may be allocated for housing programs
  - Be adopted by ordinance or resolution by the local jurisdiction
- Any new <u>commercial/industrial</u> CET must:
  - Be adopted by ordinance or resolution by the local jurisdiction
  - 50% to housing programs, 50% unrestricted
