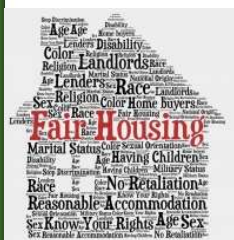

Fair Housing Needs



- Fair Housing is the right for people to be free from housing discrimination in all types of housing transactions
- Housing discrimination based on disability makes up 50% of enforcement contacts
- Additional issues: national origin, familial status, source of income, harassment based
- For Bend – how do we make fair housing information accessible throughout the year with limited resources to host trainings?



Proposal

Two virtual educational workshops to serve:

- **Housing Providers serving low-income individuals and families**
 - Will cover fair housing law, enforcement processes, reasonable accommodation requests, COVID-19, assistance animals, harassment issues, and resources for technical assistance.
- **Consumer Advocates and Case Managers**
 - Will cover all aspects of fair housing law, enforcement processes, and resources for technical assistance.



Proposal

- **Trainings will be recorded and available for use up to one year after completion of training**
