



## Thrive Central Oregon

- ▶ Thrive Central Oregon helps overcome housing and financial insecurity in our community through a holistic approach that connects families and individuals to the resources they need
- ▶ Last service year reflected connection of 1502 individuals to the supports they sought:
  - ▶ Housing- 1711
  - ▶ Healthcare- 222
  - ▶ Employment- 81
  - ▶ Social Security- 36
  - ▶ Basic Needs- 421
- ▶ Services currently remote: phone, mail & virtually
- ▶ COVID-19 impact= increased need and urgency for service support
  - ▶ Risk of homelessness doubled, from 25%-50%
  - ▶ Latinx population disproportionately impacted. Service requests @ 3x that of white households.
  - ▶ Expansion to rent/ mortgage & utility payment support



# Proposal



- ▶ Requesting \$53,153 to support staffing needs in Bend
  - ▶ Program growth to address financial assistance
  - ▶ Increasing number of calls = increasing need for staff
  - ▶ Upstream approach to help families stay housed
  - ▶ Thrive services to empower families to utilize every possible resource available
  
- ▶ Bend CDBG funding is set to start when our current Eviction Moratorium ends.
- ▶ Secured funding from Collins Foundation to support services in Bend through CY 2021. Pending request to OHCS-ESG for Latinx support in Bend, through 06/2022.
