

## COMMON PARKING VIOLATIONS AND SCHEDULE

The most common parking violations and the citation fee for parking citations according to the type of violation. The fee schedule is set by Bend City Code Fee Schedule.

## Most common parking violations

Violation	Details	Amount	Late Fees
Overtime Parking Downtown	To help with vehicle turnover in downtown Bend parking spaces have 2 hour time limits. If you stay beyond the posted time limit, you may be subject to a citation. To avoid a citation, you must move your vehicle to a parking area that is 750ft away.	\$25	\$13 discount for 3 days \$20 at 10 days \$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Overtime Parking	To help with vehicle turnover in recreational and small business areas, parking spaces have time limits. If you stay beyond the posted time limit, you may be subject to a citation.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Meter Violation	When you park in a paid parking area you must pay for parking. If you have not paid via a mobile app or the pay-	\$25	\$13 discount for 3 days \$20 at 10 days

Backed Into Parking Stall	For safety reasons every parked vehicle in Bend must park front first when parked in <b>angled</b> or <b>parallel</b> parking spaces. Backing into these parking spaces on public roads or parking lots is not allowed.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Parked against the flow of traffic	You must park your vehicle facing in the direction of traffic when parallel or angle parking. Motorcycles may angle park in a parallel space. Failure to park in the direction of traffic may be subject to citation.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Compact only Stall	To maximize parking capacity, some areas have smaller parking spaces called "compact only space". If your vehicle is longer than 187", you should not park in this space or you might receive a parking citation.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Not Parked Within Marked Space	Parking spaces are defined by white lines. Every vehicle must be parked within those lines. Vehicles parked beyond these lines are subject to parking citations.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
No Parking	You are not allowed to park anywhere with yellow curb markings or where there is a "no parking" sign.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days



	If your park your vehicle here, you may be subject to citation.		
Parking Illegally in a handicapped space	You cannot park your vehicle parked in front of an ADA spaces unless you have a valid ADA placard or you may be subject to citation.	\$165	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Blocking ADA Access Aisle	You cannot park your vehicle parked in front of an ADA access ramp. Please ensure that you are not blocking an ADA ramp while you park, or you may be subject to citation.	\$165	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Altered ADA Placards	You cannot modify your ADA placard.  Beside the high citation fee, you might risk losing your ADA placard.	\$440	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Parking within 10 Feet of fire hydrant	You cannot park within 10 feet of a fire hydrant in any location. The fire hydrant does not have to be posted by signs or a yellow curb.	\$115	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Residential Permit Parking Only	You parked in a permit only area without a valid permit. These areas prioritize parking for residents of that area, if you live here, you can get a permit at bendpermits.rmcpay.com	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Snow emergency parking violation	During snow emergencies with heavy snow fall, you are not allowed to park here to ensure city crews can clear the roadways in a timely fashion. If	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days

Parked Within 20 Feet of a Crosswalk	You cannot park within 20 feet of a crosswalk in any location. The crosswalk does not have to be posted by signs or a yellow curb.	\$115	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Parked on a Sidewalk	To protect pedestrian safety, you cannot infringe on a sidewalk at any time.	\$115	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Blocking Driveway	Blocking driveways is not allowed.  Besides a parking citation, a vehicle parked in front of driveways might be subject to removal.	\$115	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Parked in Bicycle Lane	Bicycle lanes are for bikes not cars.	\$115	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Parked In An Alley	Alley's in Bend have an important role in providing access to homes for Bend community members and deliveries for local business. You can stop and unload for 15min, but please move after so we do not need to ticket you.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Expired Registration	Vehicles parked on the public right- of-way must have current registration.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Blocking the flow of Traffic	If you vehicle infringes into the drive lane it can cause traffic congestion and put others in danger. You risk	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days

Not a valid space	Valid parking spaces are identified by lines and markings on the ground or signage. If signs are present, arrows indicate where parking areas begin and end. If you park outside these areas, you are subject to a parking citation.	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
No valid permit - Downtown District	You parked in a permit only area without a valid permit. These areas prioritize parking for residents and permit holders, if you live or work here, you can get a permit at bendpermits.rmcpay.com	\$50	\$15 at 30 days \$15 at 60 days
Warning	Review the reason for this warning and remember to park better next time.	0
