Municipal Court Security

THIS MATTER came before the Court on its own motion, having determined the need for certain rules governing security measures in and for the Court. The COURT HEREBY FINDS that possession of Weapons in a public building, including the Court Facilities, is generally prohibited under ORS 166.370(1); however, ORS 166.370(2)(b) authorizes the presiding Judge to enter an order permitting possession of specified Weapons in the Court Facilities. Now. therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Court Facilities shall be free of Weapons.
- 2. The following persons may possess Weapons within the Court Facilities:
 - a. Any Enforcement Officer while acting in the scope of his or her employment (including any and all firearms or weapons normally carried as duty weapons, including but not limited to: batons, mace, pepper spray, handguns, Tasers, etc.); and

b. A Judge while acting in the scope of his or her employment.

3. To ensure compliance with this Order and all applicable statutes, rules or regulations, any person entering the Court Facilities may be

required to submit to a search for Weapons by an Enforcement Officer of his or her person and any property in his or her possession.
