General Order No.: 101

THIS MATTER came before the Court on its own motion, having determined the need for delegation of certain authority to resolve violation offenses for the efficient disposition of the Court's business; the Court HEREBY ORDERS pursuant ORS 153.800 et seq.:

- Establishment of Violations Bureau. The Court hereby establishes the Bend Municipal Court Violations Bureau.
- 2. Violations Bureau Hours of Operations. Contact the clerk at (541) 388-5572 and press 9 Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. to obtain current hours of operations.
- 3. Designation of Violations Clerks. The Court designates and appoints all duly appointed Bend Municipal Court clerks as violations clerks pursuant to ORS 153.800. The violations clerks shall serve at the direction of the judge and pursuant to this General Order 101 and the laws of City of Bend and the State of Oregon.
 - 4. Scope of Authority of Violations Clerks.
 - a. Persons who have been found guilty of, or who have entered a plea of no contest to one or more traffic offense(s) in the 12-month period directly preceding the date of the alleged offense are permitted to appear before the violations clerks.

- b. All other persons are permitted to appear before the violations clerks; however, the clerks are not authorized to offer a reduction in the fine nor participation in any court programs for the following:
 - i. A violation/infraction for which the presumptive fine/penalty
 is enhanced, omitted, or is not legible;
 - ii. A violation for careless driving involving an accident pursuant to ORS 811.135;
 - iii. A Class A violation/civil infraction; and
 - iv. A citation issued to a person age 18 or younger at the time of the violation/infraction.
- c. The following violations/infractions require a mandatory appearance either in writing or in person:
 - i. All violations/infractions issued as a result of behavior affecting an individual who has not yet attained the age of 18; and
 - ii. A violation of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations.
- d. Violations clerks, at the direction of the judge, shall enter an order requiring the person to attend an approved traffic safety class as a condition of conviction for a violation of driving a motor vehicle while using a mobile electronic device under ORS 811.507.
- e. Except as otherwise allowed for in Local Court Rule 23, violations clerks, at the direction of the judge, shall enter an order requiring the person to attend an approved traffic safety class as a condition of conviction for the following violations:

- i. A violation for violating a speed limit pursuant to ORS
 811.111 for a speed greater than 10 mph of the posted speed within the city limits of Bend, excluding the violations occurring on U.S. 97; and
 ii. A violation for violating a speed limit pursuant to ORS
 811.111 for a speed greater than 20 mph of the posted speed on U.S. 97
- 5. No Preemption of Defendant's Right to Appear in Court. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to prevent any person from appearing in the Municipal Court before the judge at the time and place set for the person's arraignment or first appearance.
- 6. Effect on Prior Orders. This Order supersedes any and all prior orders of this Court concerning the matters herein and shall remain in effect until amended, superseded, or vacated by this Court.
