
BMPO Overview

 Local agency staff plus state and federal representatives, includes 2 citizens



BMPO Overview

- MPO Manager
 - Focus on Policy and Coordination
 - UPWP, Model, Project/Program Delivery, TSAP
- Senior Planner
 - Focus on Project Delivery
 - MTP, Mobility Hub Study, Title VI/EJ
 - Continue at 0.8 FTE (4 days/week)
 - Make permanent in FY2021-22
- Program Coordinator
 - Focus on Program Delivery
 - Budget, Grant Management, MTIP, Website, TSAP, meeting facilitation online/in-person
 - Project time limited
 - Development of Crash and Volume data



BMPO Overview

Administrative update

- City of Bend reorganization in 2020
 - MPO within City of Bend Growth Management Dept (GMD). GMD moved into the Community Development Department
 - Reorganization had minimal impact on MPO processes
 - May to impact in-kind match capacity for city staff to assist on MPO work

ODOT Coordination

 ODOT contracting limitations on A&E contracting using City procurement may limit coordination efforts with City


