4. Review and Approve TAC Meeting Summary

Data: December 2 and December 8, 2020 (Agenda Attachments A & B)

Motion 1 (10/0/1): Ms. Smith moved approval of the December 2 and December 8, 2020, draft meeting summaries as presented. Mr. Stroud seconded the motion which passed with Mr. Bergh, Ms. Breault, Mr. Bryant, Ms. Hamada, Mr. Potwin, Mr. Russell, Ms. Smith, Mr. Stroud, Mr. Viola, and Mr. Williams in favor, none opposed, and Mr. Root abstaining due to his absence from both December meetings.

5. 2021-2022 Work Program and Budget

Mr. Deke reviewed (PowerPoint) the draft fiscal year (FY) 2021-2022 work program with assistance from Ms. Napoli and Ms. Anderson. The staff summary covered current fiscal year key accomplishments, additional funding due to the COVID-19 pandemic, current work, major tasks (planned, timeline, schedule), administrative and short-term planning schedule, City traffic count program, data analysis schedule, FY 2021-22 draft budget summary, and UPWP (Unified Planning Work Program) development schedule. Mr. Deke requested TAC feedback at this meeting or in the next few weeks.

TAC concerns included how federal funding for MPOs is calculated, flexibility of COVID-19 pandemic funding, traffic count data (date range, inclusion of BPRD trail counts), readiness to support more electric-powered vehicles, potential partners (Bend-La Pine School District, BPRD), and MPO staffing resources.

6. Bend and Deschutes County Transportation Safety Action Plans Implementation

Mr. Deke, with assistance from Ms. Napoli and Ms. Anderson, provided (PowerPoint) an overview of the City and County TSAPs developed in 2019. His summary included focus areas and schedule through September 30, 2021. The MPO has secured grant funding to implement some noninfrastructure components of these plans.

7. Member Roundtable

TAC members provided updates on current projects and planning efforts:

- <u>BPRD</u>: Mr. Stroud said the park district was working to update its five-year capital improvement plan, river access plan, park development and trail development projects.
- <u>Bend-La Pine School District</u>: Ms. Smith reported the school district was still in flex due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The district plans to launch an update of its sites and facilities plan in fall 2021 which will run through February 2022. Mr. Deke requested an update in early 2022.
- <u>CET</u>: Ms. Breault announced plans to implement an Electric Technology Feasibility Study and new route scheduling software in July 2021. Changes to Bend's transit system included new Routes 8 and 9 (NE and SE Bend), increased frequency along

3rd Street and Greenwood Avenue. CET helped Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook Counties and Warm Springs submit applications for the next round of STIF (Statewide Transportation Improvement Funding). STIF funding will bring new transit dollars into the region by summer 2021. Effective 8 a.m. today, CET opened its service model to transport seniors (ages 75 and above) to vaccination centers across Central Oregon. Hoping to continue this through the CARES Act over the next few months.

- <u>COCC</u>: Mr. Viola reported 85% of students being enrolled online significantly decreased the number of cars driving up to the campus. Contrary to the increased enrollment experienced during the last economic recession, enrollment during the pandemic this year is down about 14%. The college is hoping for a full campus in fall 2021.
- <u>City of Bend</u>: No report.
- <u>Commute Options</u>: Mr. Potwin said his agency was partnering with COIC (Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council) on the research and development phase of the vanpool program. Large employers have indicated interest. Staff are working closely with the school district on a sustainability committee and assisting the City of Bend on how to educate students to use new infrastructure.
- <u>Deschutes County</u>: Mr. Russell thanked Ms. Breault for helping with STIF grant applications in the tri-county area. County projects include updating the Tumalo Community Plan, looking at rural trails from Bend and Redmond to Sisters, and updating the county Transportation System Plan (TSP).
- <u>Deschutes County BPAC</u>: Mr. Root stated the committee was working on a draft report to the Board of County Commissioners (which will be shared with the MPO if interested).
 Ms. Holzman said a subcommittee was focusing on the county TSP update, especially identifying missing links in bike and pedestrian routes that connect communities.
- <u>ODOT</u>: Mr. Williams outlined current and future projects. *US97 north interchange study:* draft final report expected within two weeks. *US97 Parkway Plan:* consultant team finishing alternative mobility targets, Oregon Transportation Commission adoption (hopefully) in May-July 2021. *US20 refinement plan* (Greenwood to eastern urban growth boundary): starting in July 2021. *Reed Market study:* joint ODOT/City (Brookswood roundabout to a location east of 3rd Street signal) starting in September/October 2021.
- OSU-Cascades: Mr. Bergh said they were looking forward to fall 2021, opening a new
 academic building and adding more on-campus parking. Other activities include
 encouraging micromobility options with the City in spring/summer 2021. Pedego, a local
 bikeshop that formerly partnered with Zagster, is trying to collect the Zagster stations
 and used bikes. He's considering partnering with Pedego to sell some of the used
 cruiser-type bikes to OSU students or other interested parties.
- <u>Citizen</u>: Mr. Bryant no report.
- Citizen: Ms. Hamada no report.

Ms. Gregor thanked everyone for the information shared at today's meeting. She reported the Commute Options Board of Directors was doing a short mid-range strategic plan. Expected completion: late spring 2021.
