Key Items Discussed

This was an optional meeting involving a field trip to the Newport Corridor project along the Deschutes River.

- Monitoring Stormwater on the Deschutes River. Attendees received an overview of stormwater
 monitoring devices for the City's Underground Injection Control Monitoring; then visited a sonde
 located in the river from the pedestrian bridge connecting Drake and Harmon Parks and Jeff
 Buystedt shared more about the City's ambient water quality monitoring program. Jeff also shared
 efforts the city has taken for flow monitoring of the stormwater system for assisting the Newport
 Corridor project.
- Newport Corridor Project Nashville Area Stormwater Facilities. Attendees received an overview
 of the Newport Corridor project from Project Manager Drew Wells, Brittany Barker, and
 representatives from the contractor crew. Attendees learned about the pipe, visiting the
 installation of new bioretention planters and manufactured treatment control devices, and
 discussing source controls and tree protection measures.
