



COVID Relief Act Funds - Review

- March 2021 \$1.5M to be allocated to Bend MPO
- Late June 2021 ODOT announces unrestricted use of funds
 - MPOs to allocate funds by Sept. 2024, complete by 2029
- **Summer 2021** MPO staff tasks
 - Other MPOs: How using?
 - Meet with ODOT, CET, County, City, BPRD for priority bike/ped-related projects
 - Multiple mentions of North Corridor bike/ped undercrossing project as an area priority
- Fall 2021 N. Corridor bike/ped undercrossing feasibility study presentation to Policy Board
 - Feasibility study to be completed Spring 2022 w/ update this winter
- Today Seeking direction on next steps
 - Wait for feasibility study update/results, or explore other options?



Agenda Item # 7: ODOT Transportation Growth Management (TGM) Grant, Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for Bend Mobility Hub Feasibility Study – Andrea Napoli

Transportation Growth Management (TGM) Grant: Bend Mobility Hub Feasibility Study

- Joint grant application submitted between MPO, City, CET in July 2020
 - For Bend Mobility Hub Feasibility Study project
 - MPO staff to serve as local project manager
 - Policy Board provided letter of support for grant
 - Grant awarded Sept. 2020
 - ODOT legal review of grant agreements/contract delayed
 - Seeking to avoid further delays to start study
 - Requesting authorization for Board Chair to sign Intergovernmental Agreement

What's a Mobility Hub?



Mobility hubs support CET's plans to transition away from its current "hub and spoke" system and provide a more "multicentric" transit system in Bend.

Project Purpose

- Build off of mobility hub conceptual planning done in CETs Transit
 Master Plan and City of Bend Transportation System Plan
 - Both identify mobility hubs in Bend as key components of transportation system
 - To improve efficiency of transit
 - Reduce vehicle miles traveled
- Our main questions...
 - What is the best approach to implementing mobility hubs?
 - What do they look like? Where do they go?
 - Who manages / owns what?





Agenda Item # 8: Project Status Updates, 2021 Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Fund Awardees – Andrea Napoli

Background

- Fall 2020 BMPO conducts first competitive project application process using STBG funds
- **Dec. 2020** Policy Board made funding awards for 2021-2024 STBG dollars
 - Policy Board requests annual project updates from awardees

Projects awarded 2021 funds:



CO Historic Canal Trail: Crossing Safety Improvements (BPRD)	\$26,000	\$64,218
Relaunch Bikeshare (COB)	\$33,750	\$33,750
SE Brosterhous Road: BNSF Pedestrian Undercrossing (COB/BLS)	\$158,718	301,250

10/11/21 Funds renounced by COB

Project Status:

- Install safety enhancements at 3 road crossings
- Project split into 2 phases
 - 1. Blakey & Brosterhous (\$26,000 in 2021)
 - 2. Ferguson Rd (\$38,218 in 2022)
- Phase 1 status
 - Contract for construction issued, completion end of November
 - Advancing \$20,000 from Phase 2 for Phase 1




Project Status: City of Bend, Relaunch Bikeshare



- Continued delays w/ computer chips needed for hardware upgrades for PBOT donated bikes
- Currently exploring other operator/provider options
