PROJECT DESIGN

The Wilson Avenue Improvement Project extends from 2nd Street to 15th Street and is currently in design. This project improves east-west connectivity and enhances facilities for biking and walking to help ensure Wilson Avenue becomes the walking and bicycling route envisioned by the City and the community. It is also defined as a synergy project because during the roadway construction, the existing water line system will also be upgraded to current standards and overhead utility lines will be moved underground.
