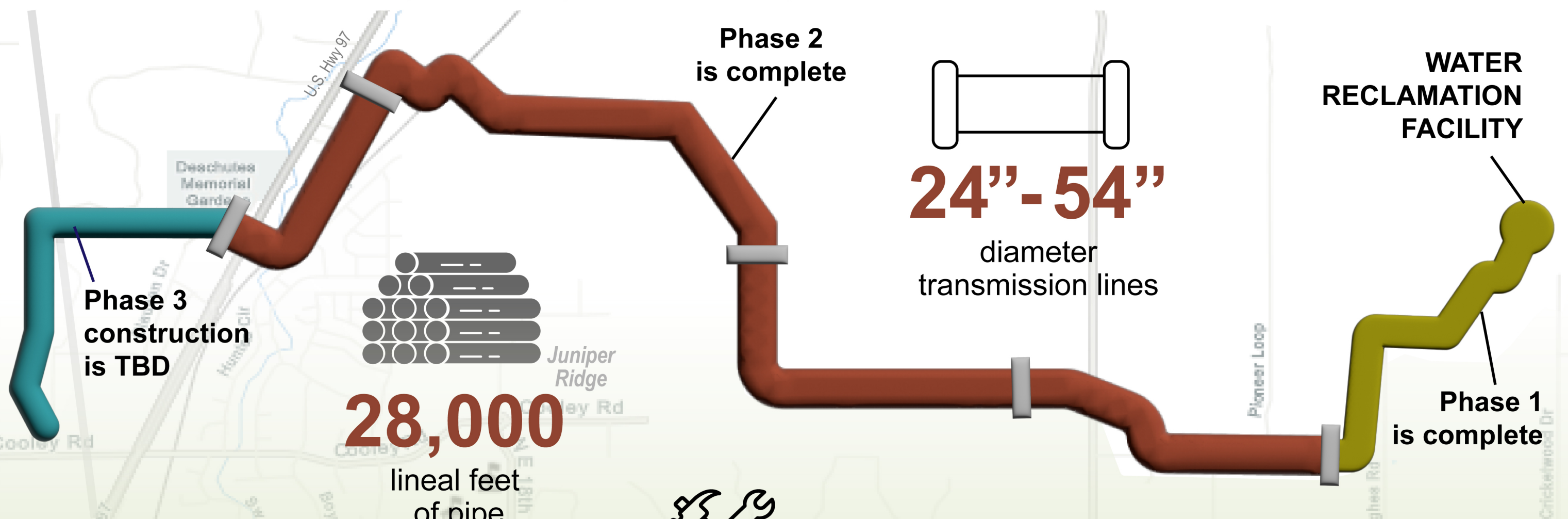


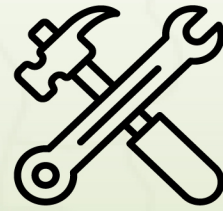


NORTH INTERCEPTOR SEWER LINE PROJECT PHASE 2

The North Interceptor Sewer Line Project Phase 2 was completed in December on schedule. The four-year effort (including Phase 1) replaced failing sewer infrastructure and constructed a new, large diameter sewer transmission line bringing sewer to the northern area City limits. Phase 1 was completed in 2020. Phase 3 construction dates are to be determined. This project opens Bend's north area to new development and future septic to sewer conversion possibilities. See below how phases 1 & 2 are already benefiting our community.

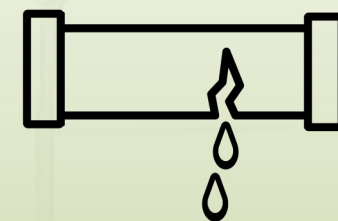

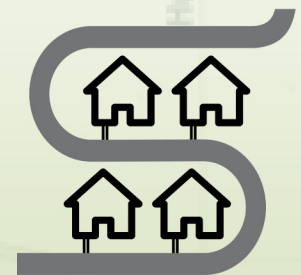
