

North Interceptor Sewer Line Project Phase 2

The North Interceptor Sewer Line Project Phase 2 was completed in December on schedule. The four-year effort (including Phase 1) replaced failing sewer infrastructure and constructed a new, large diameter sewer transmission line bringing sewer to the northern area City limits. Phase 1 was completed in 2020. Phase 3 construction dates are to be determined. This project opens Bend's north area to new development and future septic to sewer conversion possibilities.

See below how phases 1 & 2 are already benefiting our community:

- 24" – 54" diameter transmission lines
- 28,000 lineal feet of sewer pipe installation
- 15 new opportunities for lift station decommissioning
- Approximately 11,500 lineal feet of failing sewer pipe replaced
- 4 times increase in collection capacity

More benefits

- Reduces future operational costs through decommissioning of lift stations
- Long-term investment in our community to meet anticipated sewer demand
- Onsite recycling of over 220,000 cubic yards of material during construction
- Replaces failing sections of sewer infrastructure to ensure public health and safety
