







### **COMMENTS RECEIVED IN "OTHER"**




- Annual meeting notified by mail.


- I want them to stop targeting us and get back to us when we need their help that we pay for like a broken sprinkler in the system out front by the street.

- Public meetings.




#### TRUST SCALE COMPARISON
