Members deliberated the prioritization of each strategies.

3. Vote on prioritized list of strategies to recommend to full Environment and Climate Committee

All members agreed to the following ranking:

1. (ES1A) Develop a roadmap to achieve a 100% renewable electricity supply for the community
 - Notes: look to change language to reflect that the focus is on grid supplied electricity
2. (ES3B) Promote renewable energy incentives offered by utilities by providing this information during the permitting process
3. (ES3C) Create new incentive packages that increase the installation of renewable energy projects on residential and commercial buildings
4. (ES3D) Create revolving loan funds to finance renewable energy projects
5. (ES3A) Increase community education on renewable energy and available incentives
6. (ES3G) Support and expand workforce development programs in renewable energy trades
7. (ES3E) Develop community solar projects that residents can subscribe to
8. (ES3H) Create a commercial, property assessed clean energy program
9. (ES5A) Install solar panels on public buildings
10. (ES3F) Pilot microgrid and battery storage projects
11. (ES2A) Develop a program that allows residential and commercial customers to offset their gas use
12. (ES4A) Build a biodigester at the water reclamation facility after confirming feasibility of the project
