- 2. (W6A) Conduct outreach campaigns that promote food waste prevention
- 3. (W3A) Expand curbside composting program
- 4. (W2A) Utilize low carbon concrete mixes in City projects and create incentives to encourage developers to utilize low carbon concrete
- 5. (W1A) Improve recycling at multifamily residences
- 6. (W5A) Conduct outreach campaigns that promote waste prevention and reducing consumption
- 7. (W1C) Investigate and invest in facility and infrastructure upgrades to meet long term needs of solid waste system
- 8. (W5B) Implement training programs for specific industries to prevent waste
- 9. (W1B) Develop a recycling and waste reduction program targeting tourists
- 10. (W4A) Expand and develop new programs to increase recovery of construction and demolition materials
