

- Third phase of Septic to Sewer Conversion Program
 - Admiral Way
 - King Jehu Way
 - A portion of King Hezekiah Way
- Selected by Septic to Sewer committee on February 25, 2021
 - 66% property owners signed the application







KING HEZEKIAH (APRIL – JULY)

KING JEHU (MAY - AUGUST) ADMIRAL (JUNE – SEPTEMBER)

- Schedule subject to change
- 3,859 LF gravity sewer main and associated manholes
- 48 service laterals
- Full-width pavement restoration
- Traffic control on Admiral Way, King Jehu Way, and King Hezekiah Way

Road closures on King Hezekiah Way, King Jehu Way, and Admiral Way



- Local Access provided via temporary access routes; dirt/gravel roads
 - Garbage/recycle, USPS, UPS/FedEx
 - Notify City Project Manager if any services are interrupted (contact info at the end of presentation)
- Driveways may be blocked for short periods of time 48-hour notice will be given for significant closures
 - Please communicate if you have special access needs
- EMS/Fire, BLSD and other service providers notified of closures






DETOURS – KING JEHU CLOSURE

PRIVATE ENCROACHMENTS






- Timbers (railroad ties), sod, gravel, bark mulch will be replaced
- Fences, plants, trees, bushes, flowers, pavers, bricks, retaining walls, concrete borders will not be replaced
- Contractor will dispose of or stockpile improvements
- If you aren't sure, please make an appointment to discuss

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LATERALS – RELOCATION REQUEST

- Lot maps sent via US mail June 2021
- Green stakes placed in September
- Work with contractor (plumber and/or excavator) ahead of time to determine connection methods for your property
 - Two typical connection methods:
 - 1. Trench around structures to connect near septic location to the stub out
 - 2. Reverse plumbing in crawl space, then trenching to the stub out



LATERALS – RELOCATION REQUEST



- If you already requested your lateral to be relocated, we will update the stake prior to construction.
 - Reconfirm the location once the stake moves. If in doubt, reach out to Alex
- If you still need to move lateral, reach out to Alex
- All relocation requests due prior to <u>March 31, 2022</u>

Costs (valid through June 30, 2022)	Fees if Connected Within 2 Years from Notice of Operational Completion	Fees if Connected Beyond 2 Years from Notice of Operational Completion
Connection Fee	\$4,539	\$9,077
System Development Charge (SDCs)	\$5,223	\$5,223
Private costs	Vary by lot	Vary by lot
Total	\$9,762 + private costs	\$14,300 + private costs



Financial Assistance Options

- Connection Fee Waiver Program (City of Bend)
 - Qualify if household income is 80% Bend Area Median Income or less
- Craft3
- NeighborImpact

Note: fees are adjusted annually, you will pay fees that are in place at time of connection

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STEPS TO CONNECT



City

- City completes construction of sewer project
- Issues Notice of Operational Completion (NOC)

County

 Property owner obtains Tank Abandonment permit from Deschutes County Environmental Soils Dept

City

- Property owner obtains Plumbing Permit from City Building Dept
- Pay System Development Charge, Connection Fee, and permits

Connect to Sewer

- Property owner or contractor connects house to sewer
- Call in all inspections
