PROJECT AND PROGRAM UPDATES

Public Safety on Second Street

The area of NE Second Street, between Franklin Avenue and Greenwood Avenue, has been declared as an unsafe camp by the City of Bend under [Administrative Policy ADM 2021-1](#). The area also includes Greeley Avenue, Hawthorne Avenue and Irving Avenue, between First Street and Third Street. Several camps have been established in the City right-of-way, creating public health and safety issues for the people camping there and nearby residents, businesses and the traveling public.

To provide for public safety, the City of Bend will be removing and cleaning up the unsafe camp area. City provided a two-week email notification to service providers on Feb. 28. On March 10, the City provided at least 72 hours of advance notice to individuals camped in the area to vacate the location so the City can clean-up and restore the right-of way. The City is coordinating with service providers to connect individuals and families with direct and vital connections to resources and shelters. To support the camp removal and clean-up, the City will close portions of Second Street from Franklin Avenue to Irving Avenue. Greeley Avenue, between First Street and Third Street will also be closed. Closures are expected over a two-day period early next week.
