

Homeless Leadership Coalition 2022 Point-in-Time Count

The 2022 Point-in-Time Count was released today. Key takeaways are highlighted below:

- 1,286 unhoused adults and children
- 2022 Point in Time Count shows a 17% increase in homelessness over last year
- 79% of people counted were unsheltered
- 65% of those counted have lived in Central Oregon for more than 3 years
- 60% of those counted have been homeless for more than 12 months
- The total number of youth experiencing homelessness continues to climb
- Central Oregon continues to see that people of color experience homelessness at a greater rate than their white peers
