OR-7 Retreat Action Items

The OR-7 Retreat was held in Bend on Monday, May 23rd. In attendance were the City Managers and Assistant City Managers from the cities of Beaverton, Bend, Eugene, Gresham, Hillsboro, Medford, and Salem. It was a productive session with discussion focused on houselessness funding and strategy.

Below are the action items and next steps identified at the retreat to advance legislative agenda development:

- The OR-7 City Managers agreed that sustainable funding for city-initiated projects (i.e. Project Turnkey, Navigation Center, etc..) that expanded shelter capacity or services to those experiencing homelessness is the highest priority of this group to address in the FY23-25 Legislative Session; and
- The Lobbyist team representing the OR-7 Group will re-visit the homelessness strategy
 presented during the 2022 Short Session and revise based on the need for sustainable
 resources for operational needs with the goal of presenting a draft to City Council this Fall.
