- What about the Workforce development director, are they going to add another voice to solve the housing and childcare problems or are they focusing on completely different problems that this committee is not aware of?
- Collaboration with stakeholders like the land managers, the BLM and forest service are awesome, and then finding areas that can take more traffic.
- Overnight inventory, how many beds do we have, what are lodging stakeholders saying?
- I see on the risk list this reputational risk that we are facing with bad media coverage. How do you combat negative media coverage?
- In regards to the Workforce Coordinator, how will businesses learn that this resource exists?
