## **RESOLUTION NO. 3295**

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY NO. CP007 TO INCLUDE WELCOMING WEEK AND JUNETEENTH AS OFFICIAL CITY EVENTS

## **FINDINGS**

- A. On July 20, 2016, Council adopted Resolution 3037 establishing Council Policy on Discretionary Funding/Sponsorship of Community Programs, Services and Events, No. CP007 (the "Policy").
- B. The Policy set standards and criteria for the discretionary funding of community programs, services and events to promote the transparent and equitable expenditure of funds budgeted for discretionary spending. Discretionary funds awarded under the Policy are required to be used for a public purpose, consistent with City strategic plans, mission, core values and priorities.
- C. The Policy also designated several official City sponsored events that the City would budget for and fund, including the Christmas, July 4<sup>th</sup>, and Veteran's Day Parades.
- D. The City now wishes to amend the Policy to recognize Welcoming Week, Juneteenth and Central Oregon Pride as official City events.
- E. The Policy amendment also makes several non-substantive changes to align the Policy with current City budgeting and administrative practices, and clarifies that discretionary funds may be awarded by grant to qualifying programs and projects or by sponsorship to qualifying events.

1. Policy No. CP007 is amended and revised in substantially the form presented to Council to include Welcoming Week and Juneteenth as official City events.
