Oregon Mayors Association Taskforce on Homelessness Budget Proposals

At this week's Council meeting, Gena shared information regarding the Oregon Mayors Association (OMA) Taskforce on Homelessness. Since the formation of the Taskforce in May 2022, twenty-five mayors, representing cities of all sizes from around the state, studied Oregon's homelessness crisis. As outlined in [this letter from the Oregon Mayor's Association](#), the Taskforce recommends two separate, yet parallel budget proposals:

1. A budget package which provides direct allocation to cities for homelessness response and prevention services; and
2. A budget package that provides capital improvement funding for cities.
