The Monthly Revenue Report is a summary of the City's major revenue sources in terms of actual to budget variances as well as projected trends and total estimated fiscal year-end revenue.





Year to Date Actuals Analysis:

- Receipt of property taxes typically begins in November.
- Generally, revenues received within 60 days of year-end (in July and August) are recorded in the prior fiscal year and will not be recorded in this fiscal year in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).





Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Projected Revenue Explanations over or under 5%:

- -GF Room Tax revenue projections are up $^\sim$ 15% compared to budget due to higher than anticipated activity.
- -Hwy Gas Tax revenue projections are up ~6% compared to budget due to increased activity.

Note: Building, Planning, and Engineering and SDC actual revenues are trending lower than anticipated for the first quarter. Annual projections are currently at the budgeted amount, but will continue to be evaluated as the year progresses and updated in subsequent monthly reports as needed.
