

### Midtown Crossings

- Near-term (23/24) quick-build Phase I improvements on Greenwood to provide road diet
- Complete Franklin Corridor improvements and priority elements of Franklin Concept 1 crossing improvements, initiate design starting in 2023, build in (24/25). Includes Storm @ under-xing
- Reserve remaining funds for Hawthorne and continue to pursue additional funding resources
- Including CAAB Direction:
  - Add 2nd Street Improvements, Franklin to Greenwood

Note: Greenways Phase 4, separate CIP project



### **CAAB Draft Motion**

• 1st motion:

I motion to recommend a Core Area CIP for BURA to consider for adoption at their December 7 meeting as well as funding recommendations for FY2027-2028 to be used in the upcoming 2023 budget development process.

• 2nd motion:

I motion to recommend BURA prioritize remaining funds (~\$2M) to remove barriers and catalyze development in the Core Area through establishing a Development Partnership Program. CAAB asks BURA to direct staff to work with CAAB to develop program parameters and a suggested process for allocating these funds.
