Nusret,

Thank you for getting in touch with me. I am going to include this message below as public comment that will be sent to all CAAB members.

I understand your concerns and am including Janet Hruby from our Transportation and Mobility Department to see if there is a near term opportunity to coordination with Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to improve lighting at this intersection since I believe the intersection is actually maintained/operated by ODOT and not the City of Bend. The City often applies for safety grants including lighting projects and perhaps this is a location we can add to our list for a future safety grant application.

Unfortunately the CAAB agenda is already full and the funding that group oversees is limited, particularly in the early years of the district.

We have identified priority areas for the district and district funds with the Division area seen as a later year priority which is why I think Janet and safety grants may be a better near term opportunity to improve this intersection.

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Hello,

I am Nusret Aydin responding to your request that I e-mail you concerning the above subject. I spoke with you last week, after the public meeting of the Core Area Committee, and pointed out that with the second homeless shelter due to open soon on Division Street, there will obviously be an increase in foot traffic close to this residential area. This Division/Revere intersection is sorely in need of more lighting. The increase in pedestrian traffic, near and at the intersection itself, presents a serious danger, not only to the increased pedestrian traffic but also to those people who live and have businesses in the area. This intersection needs to be improved in a way that it should be able to serve pedestrian traffic as well as cyclists. Because it is one of the main arteries that connect's North East of Bend to downtown Bend. At present especially during the night it is intimidating to use this intersection to walk to downtown.

I hope your committee will take this issue seriously and include it on your agenda so it can be discussed more thoroughly.
