

**FEES RESOLUTION
FISCAL YEAR 2022-23
Resolution No. 3319**

A RESOLUTION AMENDING FEES AND CHARGES AS PROVIDED BY BEND CODE 12.15

Findings

- A. Bend Code section 12.15.005 states that the City Council may, by resolution, establish and amend fees or service charges (collectively "fees") for any and all services provided by the City. The fee shall not exceed the average cost of providing the service.
- B. The City Council has adopted an ordinance amending the Bend Development Code to remove minimum parking requirements. This Resolution clarifies the adopted Fee Schedule to remove the related in-lieu of fee.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


- SECTION 1. Resolution No. 3303 is amended as set forth below, with the changes shown as follows:

- SECTION 3. All other provisions of Resolution 3303, as previously amended, shall remain in effect.
