Bend Program-FY 23/24-24/25 Goals and Objectives:

- 1. Attract and relocate six traded-sector businesses to Bend, adding 60 well-paying new jobs.
- 2. Solidify Bend as a top 10 start-up hub, maintaining and growing the existing entrepreneurial ecosystem and promoting the Bend Venture Conference (BVC) as a premier angel investor conference.
 - a. Maintain portfolio of 80+ promising Bend start-ups
 - b. That portfolio generates at least 130 jobs
 - c. With EDCO's help, startups raise \$20M in growth capital
- 3. Through business retention and expansion efforts and strengthening industry clusters, add or retain 400 jobs in Bend's five key traded sector industries: 1) Advanced Manufacturing, 2) Scientific, 3) Technology, 4) Lifestyle Products, and 5) Headquarter/Management Operations.

Deliverables (Goals 1-3):

- Annual and quarterly reports within 30 days of each quarter end to the City of Bend that reports on status towards meeting goals and objectives above. Including;
 - Completion of Move, Start and Grow projects and number of related jobs added or retained
 - Status of pending Move and Grow projects and Start portfolio
 - Status of Start projects growth capital raised
 - Volume of outreach contacts with local businesses resulting in assistance or referrals
 - Quarterly meetings with City Economic Development staff, EDCO to organize meeting and prepare agenda
 - Summary of findings from one-on-one discussions with traded sector businesses on barriers to expansion or relocation.
- 4. Enhance the long-term financial stability of the Bend Area Program: Evaluate a fee structure to support the Bend Enterprise Zone with the Bend City Council as allowed under state statute.

Deliverables (Goals 4):

- Memo to the City of Bend by October 31, 2023 that includes research on other Enterprise Zone fees across the state, the reasons supporting a fee to support the Bend Enterprise Zone, a proposal for a reasonable fee including assumptions and proposed use of fee proceeds.
- 5. Participate in the creation and adoption by City Council of the City of Bend's Economic Development Strategy with a focus on identifying target industry sectors for recruitment and tactics to support job creation in key

geographic areas including the Bend Municipal Airport, Juniper Ridge, and Core Urban Renewal Area.

Deliverables (Goal 5):

- Participation in BEDAB meetings
- Participation in Economic Development Strategy stakeholder meetings
- Participation in the RFP process for making industrial land in Juniper Ridge available to developers
- Support City staff in reaching out to target industry sector businesses

Other Notable Goals:

- Facilitate action with local businesses and workforce development initiatives to help better prepare existing and emerging workforce. Share best practices for recruitment, advertising, hiring, and onboarding employees.
- Maintain a strong resource list of capital partners and finance resources to support start-up and growth of Bend's traded-sector companies.
- Advocate and support industry sector collaboration, associations, and strategic initiatives (like Cultivate Bend, Bend JavaScript, the Oregon Outdoor Alliance, the OSU-Cascades Innovation Hub/District).
- Participate in affordable housing initiatives that improve workforce housing availability.
- Advocate for and help to facilitate construction of new commercial and industrial space and increased industrial land supply for development in Bend.
- Advocate for increased commercial air service at Redmond Airport.
- Help the City to identify and refine the economic development objectives for Bend Municipal Airport and pursue job creating projects in support.
- Work with private and public utilities on industrial land readiness.
- Play a lead role in sustaining existing and adopting new local and statewide economic development programs that accomplish EDCO's and BEDAB's mission and strategic plan.
