Sandy Schmidt, McKinney Vento Liaison and Foster Care Point of Contact for Bend La Pine School District, provided the below breakdown of total youth identified as McKinney Vento eligible for the 2022-23 year in Bend, La Pine, Redmond, and Sisters. Of Bend's 369 McKinney Vento eligible students, 105 are unaccompanied houseless youth.
