



Discussion Item

Policy Board to revisit distribution of annual STBG funds for...

- 1. "Additional" amounts for fiscal years 2022-2024
 - Resultant of updated ODOT estimates
 - Policy Board approved a distribution method for original estimates in 2020
 - As part of development of FY 2021-2024 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program ("MTIP")
- 2. Estimated allocations for fiscal years 2025-2027
 - For development of next MTIP (FY 2024-2027 MTIP)

No formal recommendation requested; discussion item to gather TAC feedback

Background

April 2020:

Policy Board adopts FY 2021-2024 MTIP

- Established how estimated annual allocations for 2021-2024 would be distributed:
 - 60% to City of Bend Streets for maintenance/preservation
 - 15% to a competitive project application process
 - 25% to MPO required planning

Background, cont...

April 2021:


Annual amount of STBG for FY 2021 comes in +\$127,600 higher than estimated.

- March 2021: Policy Board awards these "additional" funds to projects not fully funded from past project application process (2020).
- For future "additional" funds re: FY 2022-2024, Policy Board tables discussion on how to distribute to Spring 2022.

Currently...

Policy Board to revisit distribution for...

- Estimated, annual "additional" STBG funds for fiscal years 2022 2024
- Estimated, annual STBG allocations for fiscal years 2025 2027



Possible Scenarios for Policy Board

Example 1

Apply previously approved splits to ALL funding years / amounts

- 60% City of Bend Streets (maint./pres.)
- 15% Project Application Process
- 25% MPO Planning

Example 2

Roll "additional" funds (2022-2024) into next project application process, *AND*...

apply previously approved splits to future allocation estimates (2025-2027)

For reference...

"Additional" Funds

2022	2023	2024
+\$332,700	+\$359,000	+\$385,800

Future Allocation Estimates

2025	2026	2027
\$1,618,200	\$1,646,100	\$1,674,500

Example 3

Roll "additional" funds (2022-2024) into next project application process, *AND*...

- Freeze City at \$723k
 per year for 2025 2027 (previously approved amount)
- Remaining future allocation amounts to next application process and MPO planning
