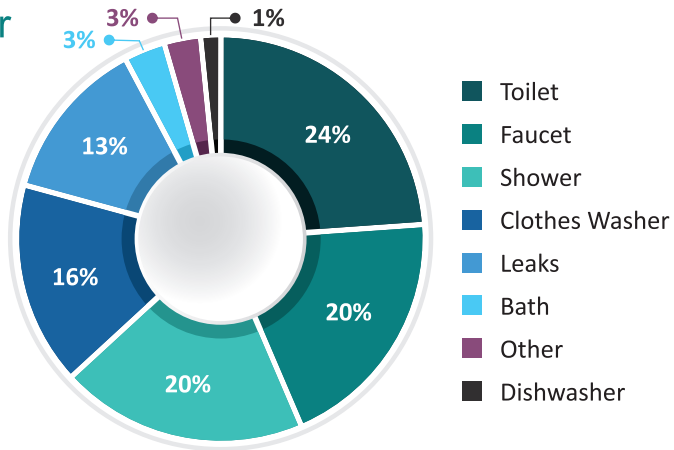


## Average Indoor Water Use By Device



## Water efficient devices are just one piece of the puzzle.

Up to 40% of City of Bend water is used indoors. Through a water system master planning effort, the City of Bend has identified the need for a reduction of peak demands by 2040 to offset expensive new investments in the water system. The devices available for a rebate are proven to save water and money. Eligible products can be used alone or in combination. Conservation of our community's water supplies creates resilience to drought and delays the need for costly infrastructure investments, keeping water rates affordable.

# How to Apply

Water account holders apply for a rebate through WaterSmart: [bendoregon.gov/watersmart](http://bendoregon.gov/watersmart)

## Single Family Residential (SFR) Customers

- Purchase and install eligible devices
- Submit application for the rebate within 60 days of purchase

## Multi-Family Residential (MFR) Customers

- Submit an application and schedule a pre-inspection
- Purchase and install devices within 90 days and schedule a post-inspection

Qualifying rebates are applied to the account holder's utility bill.



Product	Rebate Amount*	SFR Quantity	MFR Quantity**
High-Efficiency Toilet	\$80	2 max	No min/max
High-Efficiency Washing Machine	\$100	1 max	No min/max
Hot Water Recirculating Pump	\$100	1 max	1 max
Faucet Aerator	FREE	2 max	Site Specific
Shower Head	FREE	2 max	Site Specific

\*The total bill credit will not exceed the purchase amount per device and does not cover costs associated with labor.

\*\*The maximum combination of rebates per multi-family site cannot exceed a total of \$4,000.

# Eligible Product Information

The sustainability of our water sources depends on Bendites making conservation an everyday routine. When looking for indoor appliances look for the WaterSense and Energy Star labels.

- 1. High-Efficiency Toilet**  
 Eligible toilets must be WaterSense approved ( $\leq 1.28$  gal/flush).
- 2. High-Efficiency Washing Machine**  
 Eligible washing machines must be Energy Star approved ( $\leq 14$  gal/load).
- 3. Hot Water Recirculating Pump**  
 Eligible pump types can be controlled by either timer, thermostat, sensor or automated.
- 4. Faucet Aerator**  
 Available faucet aerators provided by the City of Bend are free upon request and include those produced by AM Corporation Group ( $\leq 1.5$  gal/min).
- 5. Shower Head**  
 Available shower heads provided by the City of Bend are free upon request and include those produced by AM Corporation Group ( $\leq 1.5$  gal/min).
