

RESOLUTION NO. 3378

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BEND CITY COUNCIL RESCINDING THE
CITY COUNCIL COMPUTER / NETWORK ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY**

Findings

- A. On September 3, 2008, the City of Bend (the "City") City Council adopted Resolution 2719, The City Council Computer / Network Acceptable Use Policy, which outlined the acceptable use of computer equipment and or network resources at the City of Bend (the "Policy").
- B. The field of information technology ("IT") has evolved significantly in the more than fifteen years since the Policy was adopted. The Policy is now outdated and will be replaced with administrative policies adopted by the City Manager and City IT Department.
- C. The City Council therefore now wishes to rescind the Policy effective immediately.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Resolution 2719 is rescinded.
- 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon passage.


