This form is intended for appeals of Winter Quarter Average, Winter Leak and Leak adjustment requests. Please check the corresponding adjustment or appeal. The City does not reimburse for any parts or repair costs that were incurred because of the leak.

If appeal decision results in an adjustment to the WQA, the change will be made and reflected on the next City billing cycle, which may result in a retroactive adjustment. No adjustments will be made for billing dates prior to the date that the appeal was initiated. Appeals will be complete no later than 90 days from of the date that the City receives the completed request form and all required documentation.

To qualify for an adjustment/appeal, the following conditions must be met, and form completed:

LEAK ADJUSTMENT

- The leak must be repaired, and the repairs must be permanent. The calculated credit will be provided for 50% of the excess consumption.
- The City of Bend allows a customer no more than one water leak adjustment per water meter in any 24-month period.
- This form and documentation (invoice) must be received within 60 days of the repair of a leak.
- A water leak is defined as an unpreventable break in the water and/or sprinkler system.

Some common examples of a water leak:

Frozen pipes due to inclement weather, tree roots causing breaks in the system, or broken parts within the system.

Some common examples of constant consumption that are not a water leak:

Hose left running, water feature, valves not closed correctly, or faucets left open intentionally or by accident, improper use, settings or management of sprinkler system.

□ WINTER QUARTER AVERAGE APPEAL

- Appeal must be made within the first **120 days** from bill date reflecting new Winter Quarter Average (WQA).
- Customer must provide documentation showing actual water consumption for the most recent full 3-month period. This documentation would be your water consumption history from your water provider if other than the City of Bend.

WINTER LEAK ADJUSTMENT REQUEST

- The leak must have occurred during the months used to calculate the WQA (December, January and February).
- The leak must be repaired, and the repairs must be permanent. The completed "WQA Winter Leak
 Adjustment Request" form and documentation, such as repair invoices, must be submitted to the City's
 Utility Billing office by June 30th of the current year.
